How is Honors and AP different than College Prep? *(Put Simply)*

1) **Pace**

- Courses move faster to keep you challenged.

2) **Depth**

- You have to know the “why” not just the “what” in the topics you study.

3) **Complexity**

- You have to read between the lines and make connections that aren't said by the teacher or in the textbook.

4) **Novelty**

- You will be asked to connect the units to your own life, (even if it isn't obvious to you).

5) **Weighted Grade Point**

- AP and Honors courses are worth 5 points on a 4 point scale

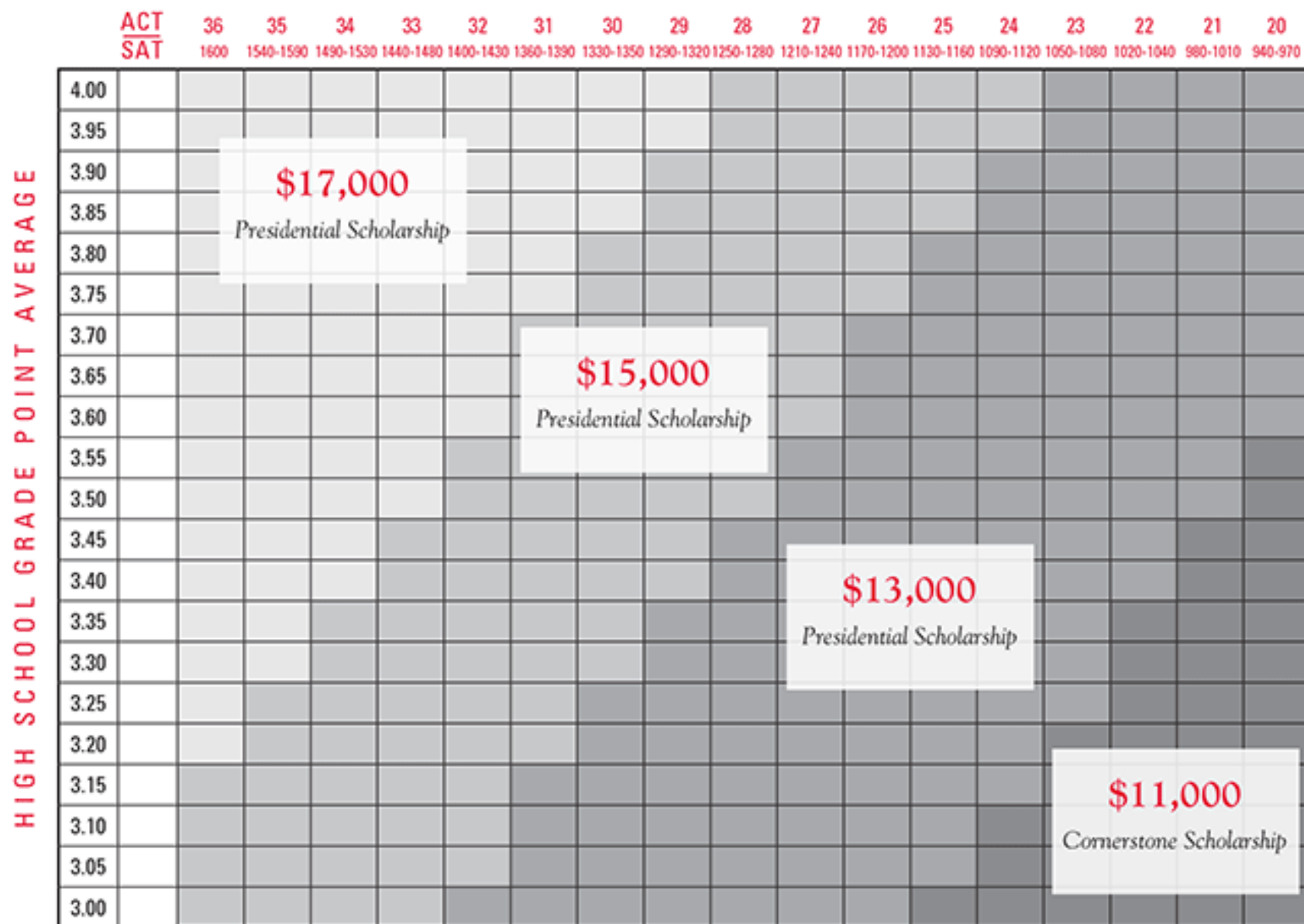

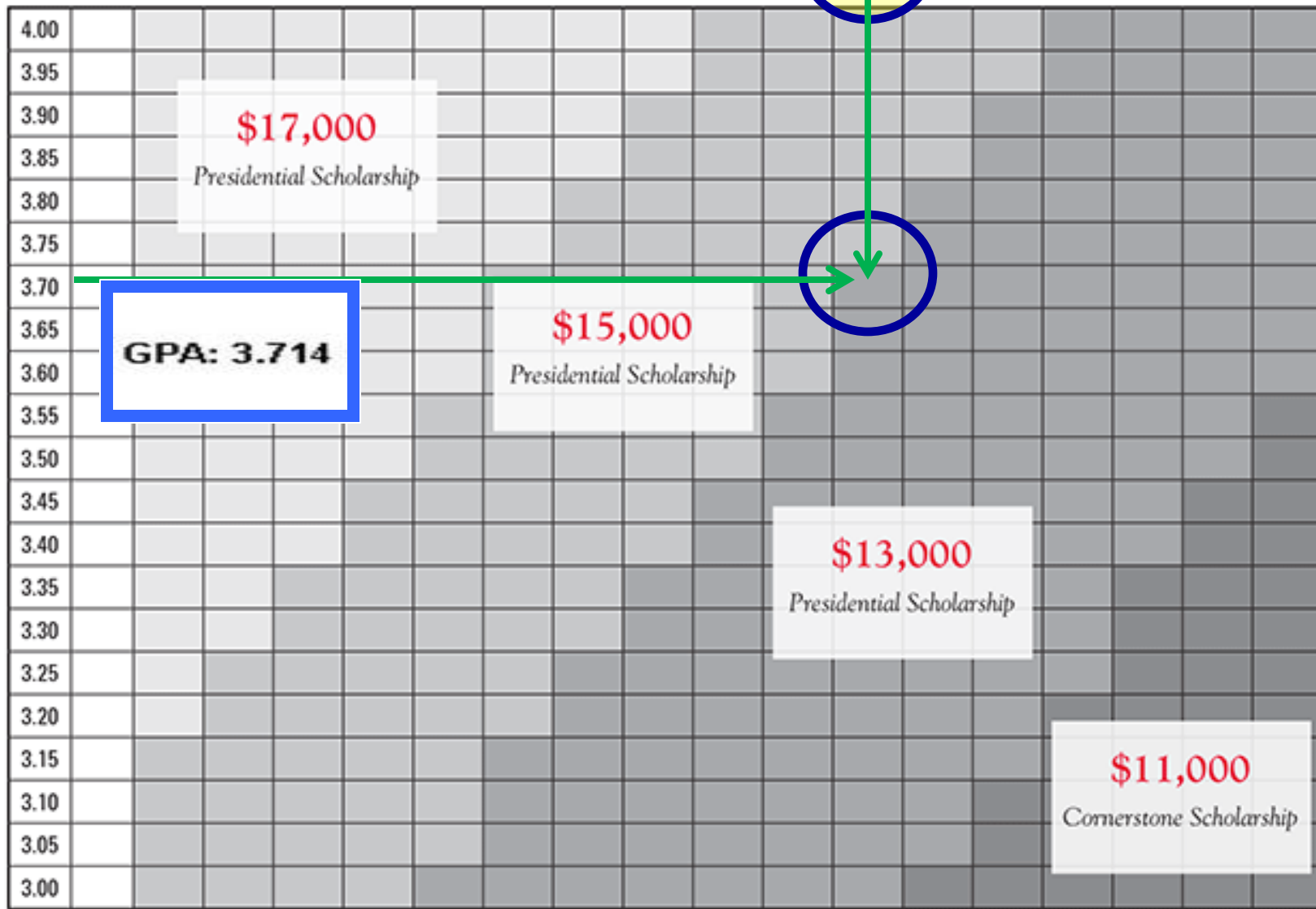

How does a bad grade impact GPA?

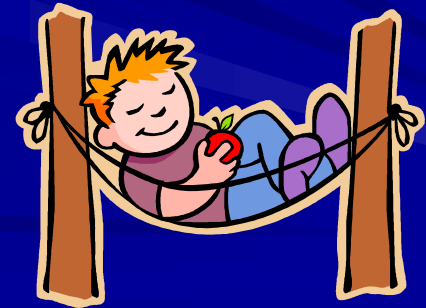
■ Based on 28 credits:

- An “F” on a transcript lowers GPA by .07
- A “C” on a transcript lowers GPA by .04
- A “B” on a transcript lowers GPA by .02

A GPA of 3.97 would fall to 3.90 with one “F”

How many Honors classes should I take?

- That is up to **YOU**.

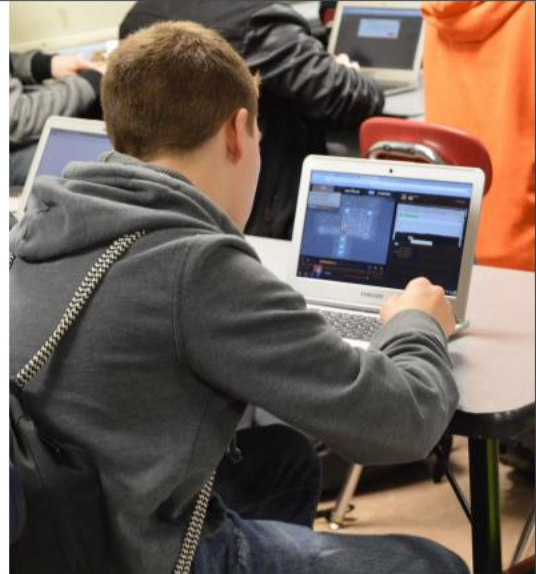

COLLEGE ACCELERATION PROGRAM

ASSOCIATE OF ARTS DEGREE

- The Fox C-6 School District partnered with Jefferson College to offer students who qualify, apply and are accepted into C.A.P. the opportunity to earn an AA degree while earning a high school diploma
- Qualifications to receive a letter to apply (sophomore year)
 - 3.8 unweighted GPA
 - two or more honors courses
 - a PLAN/ACT ASPIRE score of 20 or higher
- If you meet the qualifications above and choose to apply you will also have the following steps to meet to be accepted based on a multi frame matrix rubric
 - interview process
 - essay
 - teacher recommendations
 - ACT and COMPASS minimum scores in Math and English

(NOTE: qualifications are subject to change per Jefferson College AA requirements)
